POSITIVE PROGRESS!

Logan has reduced vision in one eye and as a result doesn't use his eyes together and has poor depth perception. Logan is receiving vision therapy for his Amblyopia by using Virtual Reality goggles and a program that Sisu funded.

The optometrist reported that Logan is "...making a huge improvement on his depth perception.

This has actually progressed quicker than I would expect."

Assisted with **Sisu** funding, June will receive four days of intensive OT, PT and Speech therapy sessions.






Three children are receiving funding for the Therapeutic Riding Center
